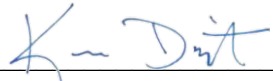

ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR ORDER MODIFYING IRREVOCABLE TRUST

1 The Petition for Order Modifying Irrevocable Trust (the "Petition") filed by Petitioners,
 2 Anne Macdonald and Anita Wornick, as trustees of the Anita Wornick Survivor's Trust, the
 3 Ronald Wornick GST Exempt Marital Trust, the Ronald Wornick GST Nonexempt Marital Trust,
 4 and the Ronald Wornick Bypass Trust (each created under the terms of the Ronald and Anita
 5 Wornick Revocable Trust) (collectively, "Petitioners"), came on for hearing on July 29, 2024 at
 6 9:00 a.m. After consideration of the papers submitted and all other arguments made at or prior to
 7 the hearing on the Petition, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- 8 1. The Petition is **GRANTED** for the reasons stated in the Petition.
- 9 2. The Court finds from proof made to satisfaction of the Court that (a) all notices
 10 have been given as required by law or waived, and (b) sufficient evidence has been provided to
 11 grant the Petition.
- 12 3. Ronald C. Wornick and Anita L. Wornick, as settlors and as trustees, established
 13 the Ronald and Anita Wornick Revocable Trust (the "Trust") under a declaration of trust dated
 14 October 24, 1997, which declaration of trust was amended and restated in its entirety on February
 15 28, 2019, and further amended by a First Amendment dated August 27, 2020 (as amended and
 16 restated and further amended, the "Declaration of Trust"). This Court approves the modification
 17 to Subsection (e) of Section 9.2 and to Subsection (b)(iii) of Section 9.3 of the Declaration of
 18 Trust substituting Friends of Bezalel for California College of the Arts as follows:

19 **9.2(e). Friends of Bezalel.** The sum of one million eight hundred
 20 thirty-three thousand (\$1,833,000), shall be distributed to Friends of
 21 Bezalel, located in New York, New York.

22 **9.3(b)(iii). Friends of Bezalel.** Twenty-six and sixty-seven one
 23 hundredths percent (26.67%) of the Charitable Share shall be
 24 distributed to Friends of Bezalel, located in New York, New York.

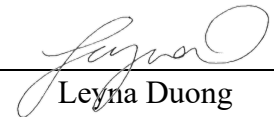
